Nine years ago around 300 people attended, whereas last year it was more than 2,000 over the two nights! This means lots of queues for those coming, traffic congestion in Heamoor and Madron and a serious impact on the garden itself. We've therefore taken the decision to **limit the numbers by making it a fully ticketed event**.
