As we are still unsure about how our return to school in September will look we have made some decisions about the structure of the school day based on parental feedback, staff views and ongoing health and safety restrictions.

The start to the school day will remain very much as it has been all year. We will open at **8.30am** and children need to be in school by **8.50am**. Children can be accompanied into the playground by an adult. Parents of our new Foundation children are able to take their children across the playground to the door of the classroom.

We are going to continue to have a staggered end to the day to make it easier for parents but the time slots will be much closer so that it does not have as much impact on older siblings of the younger children. We ask that all parents, except for parents of Foundation children, continue to wait on the slope.

3pm Foundation parents can cross the playground to collect their children . Please queue on the slope by the side of the classroom. Older siblings will come into the playground at 3.05pm.

3.05pm Y1/Y2 class and any older siblings, including siblings of the Foundation children will come out.

3.10pm Y2/Y3 class and any older siblings

3.15pm Y4/Y5/Y6

Free School Meals / Pupil Premium

At this time, many families may find themselves eligible for Free School Meals and Pupil Premium who previously did not meet the criteria. Please read this page carefully to find out if you are now eligible. Cornwall Council are continuing to process new applications for Free School Meals. **Please ensure that you read the eligibility criteria before applying** and complete the online application form if you are eligible.

Postal applications are currently not being accepted but, if you are unable to apply online, you can call the Free School Meals team on 01872 323298 and a member of the team will call you back to complete the application over the phone.

Your child may be eligible for benefits-related free school meals if you, or the child themselves in their own right, receives any of the following benefits:

- ◆ Income Support (IS)
- ◆ Job Seekers' Allowance (Income-Based) and equal based Job Seekers Allowance
- ◆ Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR) and equal based Employment and Support Allowance
- ◆ Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of less than £16,190
- ◆ Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- ◆ Guarantee Element of Pension Credit (GPC)
- ◆ Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA) Support
- ◆ Universal Credit - Your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get) as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods
- ◆ If you are claiming the benefits listed below you are **NOT** eligible for free school meals, regardless of what other benefits/credits are being claimed:
 - ◆ Working Tax Credit
 - ◆ Contribution-Based Job Seeker's Allowance and/or Contribution-Based Employment and Support Allowance

However, you will be temporarily eligible to claim free school meals if you receive a **Working Tax Credit run-on**, which is the payment you may receive for a further four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
