Live from school, a concert by Humphry Davy Scholars, with our own Harry Bosworth as a grown up teacher! The children really enjoyed it.

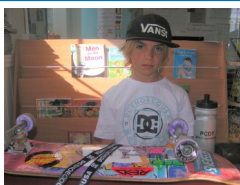


Summer Show
