## TPAT Ofsted Inspection

We are very proud to be part of the TPAT academy trust and quite rightly so according to Ofsted. During the inspection an inspector came to Newlyn and I talked to him about the support we have received from the Trust. I spoke particularly about things that have been put in place regarding health and safety, ensuring that the site is a safe place for children and for staff.

In their Summary Evaluation, the inspectors praised the Trust's "self-sustaining" and "self-improving" philosophy, which allows teachers to flourish while retaining a focus on teaching and learning. Trust schools, they said, have a "rich and customised curriculum", while "leaders have used partnership work between schools to raise standards".

Jenny Blunden, TPAT Chief Executive, shared her delight and thanks at the outcome of the Ofsted visit: "This report highlights the positive impacts of a multi academy trust for local communities, improving education, improving life chances and being a key employer. Personally, I have many to thank for their individual contributions from across our Trust for sharing why our Trust is so collaborative and so entirely focused on children and young people."

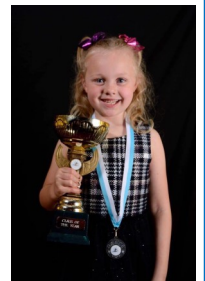


## County Cross Country
