
Brighter Smiles

Working with community dental provider Smile Together who deliver Brighter Smiles, the Society will be funding dedicated support in Newlyn School, including:

- Daily tooth-brushing clubs for nursery and reception classes
- Free fluoride varnishing for reception and year 1 to protect against tooth decay
- Education and advice for all children, staff and parents/carers to establish good eating habits and limit sugary snacks and drinks
- Home education packs for every child to help establish good practice at home
- A dedicated dental nurse to work with teachers and classroom staff

Children and staff were given a taste of the Brighter Smiles programme with a mini oral health education session delivered by Jo Trevelyan, Lead Oral Health Nurse from Smile Together.

Some of our Year 4 children were interviewed by Radio Cornwall, with a mention on Pirate FM and a write up in The Cornishman.



Our new Eco Reps Alfie and Daisy along with Jasmine, Jenna and Morgan took part in a climate change conference at Humphry Davy School.

The day started with a talk by Chris Lubbe about how 'no one is too small to make a difference'. Chris grew up in South Africa during Apartheid. From a young age he

protested against it and was imprisoned. He later went on to become Nelson Mandela's body guard. The children were very moved by his speech and couldn't wait to meet him at lunchtime!

The children then took part in four workshops.

They had lots great ideas, some of which they hope to put to the School Council.

They all enjoyed the day and they behaved beautifully.

In fact, the Mayor loved Daisy's design so much, it was chosen as our overall winner!


So not only will it be printed along with the other winning designs and
