Class 4 will be visiting Menwinion Care Home on Wednesday afternoon to share a few Christmas songs with the residents.


### **Newlyn School Art Exhibition**

However, if you are in receipt of one or more of the qualifying benefits (listed below) and you are not in receipt of Working Tax Credit, your child's school could also benefit from additional Pupil Premium funding to support your child when you complete an application form available from the office. You can apply online now at www.cornwall.gov.uk/schoolmeals
