At Stepping Stones, we care for children aged **2 to 4 years** and offer a joyful and stimulating environment where every child is encouraged to explore, grow, and thrive. #### **Structure of the day**

Our opening hours are 9:00am until 3:00pm but we offer the wrap around services listed below which are part the school not just the preschool.

Our sessions are as follows...

**Morning session:**

9:00am until 1:00pm (4 hours)

**Afternoon session:**

12:00pm until 3:00pm (3 hours)

**Whole day**

9:00am until 3:00pm (6 hours)

At Newlyn School we are incredibly proud of our offer of home cooked, delicious and lovingly prepared lunches, and would like for all Stepping Stones children to enjoy this free of charge for the time being. Of course, they can bring a packed lunch if they prefer. The Stepping Stones children will enjoy lunchtime in the main school and enjoy a playtime with the younger children in the school community. We see this as a wonderful opportunity to create the link between pre-school and school.

**How to order school meals**

Each child will receive an individual **Arbor** account login, which parents can use to select and order their child's lunch options (daily, weekly, or monthly).

**Prices for Nappies**

If you have been unable to supply a nappy, there will be a nappy charge of 50p per nappy used.

**Termly wipes charge**

If you have been unable to supply wipes, there will be termly charge of £2.00

**Funding & Prices**

Currently we will be offering all Stepping Stones families a price freeze on their hourly rate for childcare. We will work with parents over the coming months, and through consultation will implement further changes in line with government guidance when appropriate.

We are a cash free school and as such all families will be set up on the Teachers2Parents/School Money system that allows for ease of payment of pre-school fees (where required), any wrap around care accessed and school trips/visits when required. This is an online service through an app. You do not need to do anything other than complete the included admission pack and the Newlyn admin team will complete everything else for you and send you invites to all our apps.

**Wrap Around Care**

We are very proud to have the option for all Stepping Stones children to attend our wrap around care service. Breakfast club will be available for pre-school children from 8:00am and the Newlyn Wrap after school club will be available until 5:30pm each day.

The prices are as follows:

Breakfast Club: £3 per child per day – Breakfast included  
Newlyn Wrap: £3.50 from 3:00pm until 4:15pm (no tea)  
£8.00 from 3:00pm until 5:30pm (with a light tea)

### **Communication**

At Newlyn School we use Seesaw as a platform to be able to share the learning of your child/ren with you (similar to Tapestry), as well as using this as a primary communication tool. Seesaw is an app that you will receive an invitation to. You will be issued with a QR code that you can scan and link yourself to your child's profile. The communication part to the app, will give you direct contact to your child's main teacher – Miss Stacey. This is a messaging service, similar to 'Whatsapp', that gives you an opportunity to communicate directly with your child's class teacher and share messages with them. Equally messages can be shared with you as well as updates sent out via this service.

Our public Facebook page will also be a platform where our successes will be shared. Please like our page and follow us.

### **Our Pre-School Day**

We are immersed within the school community which allows for a great space for exploration and many more opportunities. We have access to a wonderful Forest School area that is freely available to the children as well as a magical school library, inspiring music rooms and lessons as well as much more; including the use of the school minibuses for trips and visits.

Our curriculum incorporates the Early Years development plan with the introduction of Little Wandle to promote the children's phonics as they develop. The curriculum will continue to develop to incorporate a balance of all core skills as well as meet all children's holistic and emotional development.

We are very lucky to have the support of a Trust of specialists who work alongside us, to ensure the provision for all children is coherent, progressive and purposeful; allowing all children to thrive.

Each day the children are offered a free hot lunch provided by our onsite chef.
