Parents' Evening

Usually we hold Parents' Evening during this half term so that we can let you know how your child is settling in school. We think these conversations are too important to miss so, although we are unable to hold face-to-face meetings, class teachers are going to offer all parents a telephone appointment instead to take place during this half term. These appointments will last 10 minutes and will give you an opportunity to share any concerns and to find out how your child is doing.

My child is not feeling well

If your child is under the weather then please keep them at home for 24hours to monitor them and let the school know. If they develop Covid symptoms such as a temperature or sore throat then please call 119 to arrange a test or go online and order a postal test. Please also let the school know if you are doing this as we now have to report the number of children who are showing symptoms.

Please be vigilant

Cornwall and the Penzance area have gone from a low to a moderate risk with cases of the virus rising rapidly. Please follow the government guidance and keep yourselves safe, observing social distancing at all times. If you have any symptoms then self-isolate, get tested and let us know. Thank you.
