The children were a real credit to school and their parents. Their behaviour was outstanding on this trip. Emily and Tom, from the Eden Team, told the children all about the Project and its aims. The children were taught about seeds and were able to plant their own nasturtium seeds. They loved the magnifying glasses!



Y5 visit to the Minack

Year 5 enjoyed their last morning of the spring term at the Minack Theatre. They had shared the play, 'The Tempest' in class and then visited the Minack to take part in a workshop. They had a tour of the theatre, including back scene (dry rehearsal places and dressing rooms), and then took part in some drama games, before performing small sections of The Tempest play.



Meeting an Artist

Our Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 children will have an amazing opportunity. On 16th May, they will go to Newlyn Art Gallery and meet Denzil Forrester who is an artist and has an exhibit in the gallery. He will talk about his work with the children. He will then come to Newlyn School and work with the children, showing them how to do gesture drawing. Our Year 6 children will be taking their SATS, (statutory tests), during the week beginning May 9th. The tests will take place first thing each morning from **Monday 9th - Thursday 12th. May. Trip to Falmouth Art Gallery

Year 5 and 6 had a fantastic trip to Falmouth Art gallery at the end of last term. The children received tours around the Polperro exhibition, full of incredible oil paintings, and a Pop Art Exhibition. Here they even saw a piece by the most famous Pop artist, Andy Warhol. The children were incredibly reflective and took their time observing each piece - it was fantastic to see.

Each year group then received a workshop in the gallery. Year 5 created some wonderful moving and spinning Automata pieces while Year 6 created their own Pop Art collage. The Year 6 children used blocks of powerful, vivid colour and overlaid this with newspaper and skateboarding magazine cutouts. Every child created a powerful and unique piece of art across both year groups. As always, it was a delight to represent Newlyn school with such a brilliant group of children.
