Attendance at Newlyn School is at an unacceptably low level with around 15% of our children having the equivalent of one day off a week last term. Our overall attendance was 94.1% (a lot lower than last year and a real cause for concern.)

Research shows that poor school attendance is closely linked to poor attainment. Children who miss school can often find it very hard to catch up and can lose confidence in the classroom. We are working closely with an Education Welfare Officer who is supporting us with parent meetings. If you are having difficulties getting your children into school then please come to speak to us and we will do whatever we can to support you and your child.

Penalty Notices may be issued when a child has more than 10 sessions that are unauthorised, (1 session is a morning or an afternoon so 10 sessions is the equivalent of 5 days), within a 7 week period.

We do understand that children are ill and genuinely need to stay at home. If your child is sick then we request that, in line with the Department of Health guidelines, they stay at home for 48 hours to prevent the risk of spreading a sickness bug. You do need to let us know if your child is going to be absent from school so that we can record it as an authorised absence.
